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Friday afternoon at 2.15pm finds everyone gathered in the hall for about 20 minutes to celebrate a few of the good things that have happened in school during that week. Various awards and special mentions are made:

- Worker of the week – One child from each class is awarded a certificate for working extremely hard during the week. They also have their photograph displayed in the school foyer for all to see.
- Citizen Award – Special mention is made of up to four children from each class who are nominated each week, usually by the children themselves, following a 'Circle Time' discussion in class linked to our weekly PHSE (Personal, Health and Social Education) theme.
- Headteacher's Award - Children who have visited Mrs Hipwell or Mrs Ham during the week to show some exceptional work or tell of their good deeds are also congratulated.
- 'Gotcha' Cup – The children are always most excited to find out which team (Comets, Stars, Planets or Asteroids) has received the most points ('gotcha' cards) across the whole school. The outcome is often different from the individual class results which simply adds to the excitement! The winning team has their colour ribbon tied on to the cup and it is kept on display by the main office.

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
